About This Settlement

Individuals detained at Smith County Jail after their felony sentence ended may be eligible to claim at least \$666.44 per day from a class action settlement.

Who Is Eligible?

Class members must complete the following criteria: Smith County Jail detained them between July 11, 2021, and Dec. 31, 2024. They completed a custodial felony sentence during that period. Smith County Jail held them for more than two days after completing their custodial felony sentence. The settlement administrator used the county's records to identify eligible individuals and sent them notices.

How to File a Claim
